The Department of Mathematics and Statistics announces one full-time (140 hours/month) Special Scientist position for the Internal Research programme «**Hyperbolic Conservation Laws: Theory and Applications**» funded by the University of Cyprus. The Principal Investigator of the programme is Professor Cleopatra Christoforou.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

The successful candidate is expected to conduct research in the field of Nonlinear Partial Differential Equations, Applied Analysis and Hyperbolic Conservation Laws. The successful candidate will have the following duties and responsibilities:

- Collaboration and support of the team towards the implementation of research objectives.
- Work together with the PI and other members to prepare research publications to be submitted in peer-review academic journals.
- Contribution to the dissemination of results and in educational activities (seminars etc.).

QUALIFICATIONS

PhD degree or equivalent in Mathematics or any other relevant field. Fluent written and verbal communication skills in English are required.

EMPLOYMENT TERMS

The position is on a contract basis for up to 11 months with a possible extension of another 6 months. The monthly gross salary is equal to € 2262,84. From the monthly gross earnings, the University of Cyprus will deduct the relevant sum which corresponds to the contributions of the employee to the various Governmental Funds and, if applicable, income tax. The position does not include a 13th Salary bonus.
